Update your chapter in your profile

A Gentle Reminder to our members:

Our member profile database has some changes and updates in the fields. We have now included a field for "Chapter" in our web database of member's profiles. I would encourage all members to log in to your profile and update your profile by picking the appropriate chapters from the dropdown menu in the chapter field. Adding a chapter field is important to identify how many members a particular chapter has and also avoids confusion as to what chapter they

belong to as some of the states have more than one chapter (like Pennsylvania, California, Virginia etc.) Members residing in a different state than the chapter they are more actively involved with can choose their chapter with whom they want to be affiliated with, e.g. some of the members who reside in Southern New Jersey are more active with the Tristate (Philadelphia) Chapter. Updated Membership profile for chapter will empower chapter presidents to reach out more members.

Once you have logged in click on my account and from the page click on edit profile button on the right upper corner. All the way down in your profile pick your chapter from the drop down menu and **once you pick the chapter please make sure to click on the Update Profile button at the bottom**. If you do not click on the update button it will not update your profile. By default the first chapter listed as Alabama is in everyone's profile till one picks and updates profile, so it is important that you log in and Edit and update your profile. Chapter Presidents should encourage members from their chapter to update their profile.
